Dear Mr. Chairman:

Section 934 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1987 states that "The Secretary of Defense shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services of the Senate and the House of Representatives a report containing a plan for the coordination of educational programs managed by the Department of Defense for acquisition personnel of the Department." The plan to improve the education and training of the acquisition work force and the relevant directives to be revised are enclosed. The Defense Systems Management College's (DSMC) mission has been expanded to include the responsibility for the coordination of high quality mandatory training and education courses of study by DoD and non-DoD sources that will prepare selected military officers and civilian personnel for assignments in acquisition career fields.

A similar letter is being sent to the Chairman of the Committee on Armed Services, United States Senate.
