

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
DEFENSE ACQUISITION UNIVERSITY
AND
STRAYER UNIVERSITY**

Introduction:

The Memorandum of Agreement formally recognizes that Strayer University and the Defense Acquisition University (DAU) will cooperate in providing educational opportunities to currently enrolled and potential students of their institutions. This agreement requires a commitment by both institutions to facilitate the transfer of DAU course credits that have been certified by the American Council on Education (ACE) toward Strayer University degrees and certificate programs without jeopardizing the intended mission and stated goals of either institution.

Purpose:

This agreement defines the structure through which articulation on all levels can be supported. This agreement is specifically designed to allow a maximum transfer of credit and a seamless transition for students. This agreement may be amended as needed without affecting the currency of the master agreement. Strayer University and DAU agree to review the agreement and transfer table annually. Strayer University will honor the input from DAU so that the most efficient transfer possible may be achieved, consistent with the applicable standards. DAU will designate an individual to serve as a liaison for the purposes of monitoring this agreement. Strayer University will provide updated catalogs annually on availability to the liaison representative at DAU. DAU will provide Strayer University an updated listing of all new ACE reviewed courses and the ACE recommendations annually, upon availability. Either party reserves the right to terminate, after 60 days prior notice, the articulation agreement when the interest of that party so dictates, subject to all reasonable efforts to ensure that existing students are not adversely impacted in completing their programs of study. Every effort will be made by either party to give 60 days' notice prior to effective date of termination and to complete the then-current programs year.

Transfer features and benefits:

1. Students from DAU will be guaranteed admission to Strayer University based on satisfaction of the admissions requirements stated in the Strayer University catalog.
2. All the ACE credit from DAU will be reviewed for transfer credit into Strayer University, not to exceed the maximum transfer for a specific degree program as listed below:

DAU courses eligible for transfer into the undergraduate or graduate program will be accepted by Strayer University per ACE credit recommendations.

Services Provided to DAU students by Strayer University:

1. Strayer University will provide counseling services to DAU students seeking information on pursuing their degree with Strayer University.
2. Students seeking credit for DAU courses not reviewed by ACE may be eligible for life assessment credit. Students should present appropriate documentation (usually a DAU Transcript) to the Strayer University campus dean for assessment in order to receive credit.
3. Strayer University will be eligible to make available to interested DAU students the transfer guide which is outlined in this articulation.
4. Strayer University will list DAU on its website as one of it's institutions with which an articulation agreement is in place.

Services Provided to Strayer University by DAU:

1. DAU will assist Strayer University in the distribution of information regarding transfer opportunities to DAU students.
2. DAU will place transfer information on the DAU homepage. DAU will update information on the home page as changes occur.

Strayer University or DAU may use the other party's name or logo in published materials (e.g. Web site and catalog) to reference this agreement or contact information/links to the others party. Content and text of all promotional information must be provided by each party prior to the release.

No agreements concerning the transfer for exchange of any assets of either party is intended or implied by this memorandum. Strayer University and DAU are separate and independent institutions of higher education and by this agreement will continue to operate as separate institutions. The administrators of Strayer University and DAU are authorized to sign, prepare and implement plans of action and procedures necessary to affect this agreement.


