Memorandum of Understanding Between The Defense Acquisition University And Trine University

1. Introduction

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into by The Defense Acquisition University and Trine University. The purpose of this agreement is to outline a strategic partnership between The Defense Acquisition University with Trine University's School of Professional Studies and School of Graduate Studies. Trine University agrees to offer undergraduate and graduate degree programs to Defense Acquisition University. This agreement is designed to facilitate the transfer of Defense Acquisition University credits to applicants seeking admission to Trine University undergraduate and graduate degree programs offered through the School of Professional Studies or the School of Graduate Studies. Trine University is a private, nonprofit university located in Angola, Indiana.

2. Purpose

The purpose of this partnership is to increase the quantity and quality of educational opportunities to Defense Acquisition University students. This Memorandum of Understanding is designed to allow for a maximum transfer of course credits and provide for a seamless transition to Trine University undergraduate and graduate degree programs through the School of Professional Studies and The School of Graduate Studies of Trine University. Trine University is dedicated to serving students from all walks of life, regardless of race, ethnicity, religion, sex, disability, color, age, marital status, national origin, or other non-merit factors.

3. Term

The term of this agreement shall be for an initial period of three years commencing on January 1, 2016. Either party may terminate this agreement by giving the other party notice to that effect 90 days prior to the planned termination date. This agreement may be extended by the mutual written agreement of the parties.

4. Responsibilities

Trine University

- Accept up to 89 transfer credits from Defense Acquisition University earned into Trine University undergraduate degree programs.
- Accept up to 6 transfer credits into Trine University graduate degree programs.
- Provide Defense Acquisition University with informational and support materials to share with interested students.
- Provide academic advising services to students requesting prior learning assessments.
- Respond directly to all students who elect to apply for admission to Trine University degree programs.
- Promptly notify Defense Acquisition University of any material changes in program or course requirements that may affect prior learning assessments.
- Provide online and residential education opportunities.
- Provide Defense Acquisition University with up-to-date curriculum.
- Provide qualified and experienced professors to teach Trine University courses.

Defense Acquisition University

- Post information regarding Trine University School of Professional Studies and School of Graduate studies degree programs, brochures and other literature in strategic locations at Defense Acquisition University campus.
- Assist Trine University in distribution of informational literature to current and former students.
- Provide official student transcripts for Defense Acquisition University courses and assist if required in obtaining proof of prior learning transfer credit.
- Allow Trine University personnel to participate in Defense Acquisition University-sponsored events related to educational opportunities.

5. Additional Terms

- Trine University or Defense Acquisition University may use the other party's name or logo upon approval in published materials to reference this agreement or contact information/links to the other's party.
- Content and text of all promotional information must be provided by each party prior to the release.
- No agreements concerning the transfer or exchange of any assets of either party is intended or implied by this memorandum. Defense Acquisition University and Trine

University are separate and independent institutions of higher education and by this agreement will continue to operate as separate institutions. The administrators of Trine University or Defense Acquisition University are authorized to sign, prepare and implement plans of action and procedures necessary to affect this agreement.

- As this strategic partnership evolves and specific opportunities for additional partnering and collaboration are identified on our programs, this Memorandum of Understanding will be updated with addenda that will reflect bilateral or multilateral agreements as appropriate.
- The individual students bear the responsibility for payment of tuition, fees, and any other costs related to enrollment in Trine University degree programs.
- Students will be subject to the policies and procedures of Trine University and must provide official transcripts and copies of completed certification documentation for the Registrar.

Trine University Guideline for Transfer of Credit to Undergraduate Degree Programs

Credits must:

- Be relevant to the specific degree discipline the student is pursuing
- Be acquired from other regionally accredited institutions, from relevant professional military programs, or Defense Acquisition University course and programs evaluated and recommended by the American Council of Education (ACE)
- Have a grade of **C** or above to be considered
- Transfer credit is limited to a maximum of 89 credit hours

Trine University Guideline for Transfer of Credit to Graduate Degree Programs

Credits must:

- Be relevant to the specific Master's degree discipline the student is pursuing
- Be acquired from other regionally accredited institutions, from relevant professional military programs, or Defense Acquisition University course and programs evaluated and recommended by the American Council of Education (ACE)
- Have a grade of **B** or above to be considered
- Transfer credit is limited to a total of 6 credit hours

Note: Trine University equivalent credits identified in this table may not be applicable to every Trine University degree program. Defense Acquisition University student's wishing to transfer credit for successfully completed Defense Acquisition University courses should contact a Trine University academic advisor for guidance.
