

 From Tully Gate: Follow directions to DAU. Stay on 18th Street, cross Flagler Road. Bear to the right side of the road, onto Galliard Road. *Please watch for signs, there are a couple of One Way Intersections!* Building 470 is on your left. Turn left off Galliard Road, the parking lot will be on your left.

ENTER POST VIA TULLY GATE.
 Any attendee without a DoD decal on his/her vehicle and who does not possess a government Common Access Card (CAC) must enter through the Tully Gate. The vehicle will be diverted to the vehicle inspection tent where the driver will be asked to show a valid driver's license. All other passengers in the vehicle will be asked to show a valid photo ID.

Continue on Pohick Rd. to Gunston Rd.
 • Right on Gunston Rd.
 • Left on 18th St.
 • Right on Middleton Rd.
 Large parking lot located on your left at 19th Street and Middleton Road. Please park in area marked "Reserved for Board of Visitors" and walk across street to the Packard Conference Center (Bldg 184).

From Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport

Travel south on Route 1/Richmond Highway through Alexandria to Fort Belvoir. There are many traffic lights, fast food places, and gas stations. An alternate route (15.3 miles) would be to take scenic George Washington/Mt. Vernon Parkway (named Washington Street in Old town) south through Old Town Alexandria. From the airport's main terminal, follow the green highway signs toward Alexandria. Proceed along the Potomac River past Mt. Vernon, historic home of George Washington, until you get to the Route 1 intersection; turn left (south) on Route 1. Go up the hill 0.7 of a mile; go past Pence Gate and continue South to traffic light, turn left and go through the TULLEY GATE for VISITOR INPROCESSING. Continue on Pohick Road to traffic light. Turn right on Gunston Road. Turn left on 18th Street. Cross Middleton Road and turn right into our campus parking lot. Parking lots located on 18th St and 19th St.

From the Maryland Side of the Beltway (Prince George's County)

Take the Beltway (I-495) across the Potomac River via the Woodrow Wilson Bridge and continue on I-495 to the exit for I-95. Go south on I-95 toward Richmond. (See From I-95 Traveling South.)

From Dulles Airport and/or Virginia Side of the Capital Beltway (Fairfax County)

Take the Dulles Access Road from Dulles Airport and exit on the Capital Beltway (I-495). Go south toward Alexandria and Richmond. As you reach the lower part of the Beltway, exit south on I-95 toward Richmond. (See From I-95 Traveling South.) (No Metrorail access.)

From I-95 Traveling South

Take this heavily congested interstate south until you are below Springfield, and take exit #166 onto Route 7100 (Newington/ Fort Belvoir exit). From this ramp you travel southeast on the Fairfax County Parkway (commonly known as Backlick Road) to Route 1/Richmond Highway. Turn left (north) onto Route 1 and turn right on Pohick Road to enter TULLEY GATE for VISITOR INPROCESSING. Continue on Pohick Road to traffic light. Turn right on Gunston Road. Turn left on 18th Street. Cross Middleton Road and turn right into our campus parking lot. Parking lots located on 18th St and 19th St.

From Richmond I-95 Traveling North

Take I-95 north to the Fort Belvoir/Mt. Vernon exit. You will now be on Route 1/Richmond Highway. Drive 6.4 miles to the TULLEY GATE for VISITOR INPROCESSING. See directions above.
