TAKE DAU-EQUIVALENT GRADUATE COURSES THAT MEET CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

If you're looking to advance your career in acquisition and supply chain management, take advantage of UMUC's educational alignment with the Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act (DAWIA) and the Federal Acquisition Certification (FAC) requirements.

UMUC is working with Defense Acquisition University (DAU) and the Federal Acquisition Institute (FAI) to help ensure that the acquisition workforce gains the skills, certifications, and academic credentials needed for increased effectiveness and career advancement.

Take the following courses at UMUC to meet DAWIA/FAC-C certification requirements while earning 3 credits per course toward your Master of Science in Management with a specialization in Acquisition and Supply Chain Management:

- **ASCM 626** Purchasing and Materials Management (equivalent to DAU's CON 100)
- **ASCM 627** Legal Aspects of Contracting (equivalent to DAU's CON 216)
- **ASCM 630** Commercial Transactions in a Technological Environment: Law, Management and Technology (equivalent to DAU's CON 200)
