

Capability Requirements Development Process Overview



- New Air Force decision body / Air Force Requirements Review Group (AFRRG)
- New JCIDS requirement for service validated **“Draft CDD”** prior to MS A
- New decision points included in Interim DoDI 5000.02
 - **Requirements Decision Point** = AF AFROC CDD validation
 - Basis for Preliminary Design Review and activities
 - **Development Request for Proposal Release Decision Point**
 - Authorizes the release of RFPs for EMD to industry





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







**UON /

- Documents critical capability gap/shortfall that could result in loss of life and/or critical near-term mission failure


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Air Force Gatekeeper (AFGK)

- **AF/A5R-P is AFGK**
 - Initial Requirements Strategy Review (RSR) for ICDs
 - Follow-On RSR for CDDs, CPDs, etc.
- **Sponsor develops requirements strategy in collaboration with key stakeholders**
 - Operator, acquisition (program manager, systems engineer, logistics, test, intelligence), others as required
- **Requirements strategy normally includes**
 - Intelligence, analysis, funding, schedule, testing, sustainment, training, and draft requirements





High Performance Teams (HPTs)

- **Sponsor drafts initial document prior to HPT**
- **1-2 week meeting to finalize document**
 - Sponsor led with AF/A5R-P guidance
 - 7-11 core participants in person
 - Operator, acquisition (program manager, systems engineer, logistics, test, intelligence), others as required
 - Support members available via phone / e-mail
- **HPT benefits**
 - Accelerates documentation process
 - Improves document quality
 - Provides enduring forum



AF Requirements Review Group (AFRRG)


- **AFRRG: O-6 level forum mirrors AFROC composition**
- **Provides corporate cross-functional review prior to AFROC**
- **Reviews documents prior to formal AF document review**
 - Quality check for critical “show stopping” issues
 - Reduces post staffing comment adjudication
- **Other AFRRG roles/responsibilities**
 - Conducts initial RSRs
 - Reviews AoA Study Guidance, Study Plans, and Final Reports





Capability Requirements Document Review

- **Required prior to meeting AFROC**
 - Mandatory 21 calendar day review
- **HQ AFMC/A5C leads AFMC O-6 review**
 - Distributes documents AFMC-wide
 - Collects and consolidates comments
 - Ensures quality comments with supporting rationale
 - Ensures comment criteria met
 - Provides sponsor with O-6 endorsed corporate AFMC position

- **Comment criteria**


- **Critical (C)**: Indicates non-concurrence with document
 - Must have convincing rationale
 - Sponsor must resolve with submitter prior to meeting AFROC
- **Substantive (S)**: Appears to be incorrect, unnecessary, misleading, confusing, or inconsistent w/ other sections
 - Sponsor need only address comment
- **Admin (A)**: Typographical, formatting, or grammatical errors

- All comments submitted must be endorsed by an O-6/GS-15
- Critical comments must be approved by AFMC/A2/5 (SES)



AFROC

- CSAF instrument to review, validate, & approve AF capability requirements, AoA study plans, and final reports
 - 1 & 2-star monthly meeting
- HQ AFMC/A2/5 is voting member
 - Validates all AFMC comments satisfactorily adjudicated
 - Provides requirements feasibility certification/attestation
- Sponsor responsible for overall briefing
 - Program Office briefs program management aspects




AFMC Validation & Certification / Attestation at AFROC

- **Validate** capability requirements documents and AoA products
 - All AFMC comments are satisfactorily adjudicated
- **Determine feasibility**
 - **Attest** requirements are feasible: “technically achievable and executable within the estimated schedule and budgeted life-cycle cost”
 - **Certify** with the SAE that requirements are feasible and can be evaluated in a source selection (ACAT I and non-delegated ACAT II CDDs)




- AFMC/CC & SAE certification or attestation required by AFI 63-101 and AFI 10-601
- Primary purpose
 - 4-star advocate for requirements issues if needed

- What are the upcoming major schedule events (as contained in the Integrated Master Schedule (IMS), if available) and confidence level (High, Medium, Low) of meeting those events? ⁷

RISK:

- Provide standard risk matrix in accordance with AF risk management guidance which depicts medium and high-risk areas. ⁸ Include risk mitigation plans.

- How would you describe overall program risk?

- Do you recommend AFMC certify or attest:

- Fully
- Conditionally (e.g. there is a technical, schedule, cost, or risk issue but a recovery plan is in place)
- Not at all

SUBJECT: Implementation of Contractual and Requirements Sufficiency

CORONA Fall Tasker-9 (CFT-9) directed AF/A3/5 and SAF/AQ to conduct "Contractual and Requirements Sufficiency." The goal of this task is to improve the understanding of the effects of requirements on cost and cycle time to inform affordability. CFT-9 directed AF/A3/5 and SAF/AQ to determine explicit steps to better vet affordability, capability, and cycle time trades in the requirements and acquisition processes. In response to this task, AF/A3/5 and SAF/AQ led a cross-functional AF rapid improvement event that identified seven root causes and seven solutions to strengthen the linkage between requirements and acquisition. These root causes and solutions were approved by the CSAF on 3 Apr 12 and by the SECAF on 30 Apr 12. In addition, the Air Force Requirements Oversight Council (AFROC) approved the implementation plan for these solutions on 19 Jul 12. AFI 10-601 and the AFROC Charter are currently being updated to reflect these policy and process changes. In the interim, AF/A3/5 and SAF/AQ will implement the following processes effective immediately:

1) **Presentation of Life Cycle Cost versus Capability Analysis.** AF requirements and acquisition processes must be complimentary and aligned with fiscal realities. Affordability discussions must take place at all GO-level requirements and acquisition forums. Presentation of life cycle cost versus capability tradeoff analysis is required for all AFROCs, Air Force Requirements Review Groups (AFRRGs), Air Force Review Boards (AFRBs), and Configuration Steering Boards (CSBs). The Implementing Commands (AFMC and AFSPC) will support the requirements sponsor by providing cost and capability analysis for all analysis of alternatives (AoA) final reports, capability development documents (CDDs), and capability production documents (CPDs). This requirement for the mandatory use of cost analysis is intended to ensure affordability is used to inform decisions throughout a program's acquisition lifecycle.

2) **AFRRG.** AF/A3/5 directs A5R to establish the AFRRG. The AFRRG replaces the current Requirements Strategy Review (RSR) and AFROC Red Team. The event-driven AFRRG will provide a corporate, cross-functional review of operational capability requirements from inception through fielding to enable better informed AFROC decision making. The AFRRG will approve the initial requirements strategy and review AF-led initial capabilities documents (ICDs), CDDs, CPDs, AoA study guidance, AoA study plans, and AoA final reports. In addition, the AFRRG will review system requirements documents (SRDs) for select programs. AFRRGs will also be conducted after the High Performance Team (HPT) and prior to initial staffing. AFRRGs will be conducted in person for HAF personnel; MAJCOM and agency participation will generally be via telecon or VTC. At the direction of A5R, the AFRRG can also be conducted electronically via Information & Resource Support System (IRSS). The AFRRG will be chaired by A-A5R. AFROC organizations will be represented at all AFRRG



Issued by SAF/AQ & AF/A3/5:

The goal is to improve the understanding of effects of requirements on cost and cycle time to inform affordability

Presentation of cost capability tradeoff analysis is required for all AFROCs, AFRRG, AFRB and CSBs.

*Codified in AFI 10-601: "Lead Command/CFLI in conjunction with the Implementing Command, produces and presents **cost capability analysis**, provides results at all requirements and acquisition forums, and includes in Analysis of Alternative (AoA) Final Reports, Capability Development Document (CDD), and Capability Production Document (CPD)"*

The AF Must Do Cost Capability Analysis



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

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

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
