

## On-site Visits (DOD Organizations, Warfighter & Industry)

Throughout the 10 month program, fellows tour selected DOD organizations, warfighter and industry locations to hear from technical experts and the senior leaders at each location. These visits provide the fellows with first-hand, eyes-on exposure to the latest technological advances in research, testing, manufacturing, training, and end user applications. On-site visits also provide the fellows with opportunities to further develop their abilities to adapt to circumstances, think effectively under pressure, and focus solutions communicated effectively to others.
