## The SSCF Program

supports leadership development of Army civilians (GS-14/15 or broadband equivalent) by offering them tools and broadening experiences that prepare them for higher levels of leadership responsibility. Individuals are board-selected by the Army for this opportunity. In March 2013, the Army approved the DAU-SSCF program as Military Education Level-1 (MEL-1) Senior Service College equivalent.

## Applicant Requirements

- ◆ Be a permanent Department of the Army Civilian at the GS14/15 or equivalent grade within a Demonstration Project
- ◆ Certified at Level III in current position, and be in an Acquisition workforce position and credentialed as an Army Acquisition Corps (AAC) member at the time of application
- ◆ Must have senior level endorsement from their sponsoring commands to be considered for central board selection

## Frequently asked questions:

*Is the SSCF a full-time program? Yes. Students selected as Fellows will be challenged with a very demanding 10-month program.*

*Will I go back to my original job after I've completed the SSCF program? It depends. The intent of the program is to continue to develop civilian acquisition leaders. The post utilization intent for Fellows completing the program is to place them in positions of greater responsibility. Therefore, your new position may be outside of your current organization or in a new area within your organization.*




