Defense Acquisition Management Information Retrieval (DAMIR)

■ A capability that...

- ⊕ Streamlines Program Management by eliminating burdensome reporting
- ⊕ Allows OSD to perform its oversight role and respond to OMB and Congressional needs
- ⊕ Leverages existing data sources
- ⊕ Reduces non-value added workload up and down the chain
- ⊕ Enables two-way information flow
- ⊕ Promotes net-centric information principles

“Transform business operations to achieve improved warfighter support while enabling financial accountability across the Department of Defense.”






BMMP Realignment Focus

- **Focusing OSD activity on the DoD Business Enterprise level architecture and associated programs, and unburdening the services from excess oversight**
- **Facilitating rapid delivery of DoD Business Enterprise capabilities that are already under the authority of the OSD organization**
- **Supporting service specific activities by streamlining approval processes**
- **Aligning governance and investments to horizontal business missions, not functional stovepipes**

- ⊕ Version 1 released in December 2003
- ⊕ Integrated into DAMIR in March 2005

■ Virtual Library

- ⊕ Net-centric solution to access unstructured information






Coming Soon

- Purview expanded to include all SAR information
 - ⊕ Eliminating hard copy SARs
 - ⊕ Classified Annex
- New data sources in the Virtual Library
- Expanded user community
- EV Pilot fully implemented
- Electronic SAR submission via Purview





Earned Value Pilot

- **Interim solution – download EVM data from Services**
 - ✦ Monthly update to CARS database
 - ✦ Army providing monthly feeds from AIM
- **Next step – Net-centric structured data solution**
 - ✦ Uses web services to pull EVM data from Services
 - ✦ Users share the same data
 - ✦ **We're almost there!**
- **Accessed through Purview**
- **Replaces Legacy EVM CARS Field data input**



DAMIR Virtual Library - Active Navigation

- Net-centric solution for unstructured data
- Guided information discovery solution
- Documents remain in existing repositories
- Documents centrally indexed from a wide range of information resources
 - ⊕ Dynamic and static document categorization (taxonomy)
 - ⊕ XML interfaces for index maintenance
 - ⊕ User access control

DAMIR for Congress

■ Background

- ✦ In Spring 2002, OSD proposed replacing current SAR with electronic access to SAR information
- ✦ Congress was receptive to proposal, but asked us to return when we had a system to demonstrate

■ Briefed DAMIR to SASC on January 18, 2005

- ✦ Demonstrated access to **SAR** information
- ✦ Requested approval to replace hard copy SARs with electronic access
- ✦ SASC Gave Green Light to Proceed

■ Trained SASC Staffers April 2005
