Mr. Roth is the Deputy Director for Investment within the Office of the Undersecretary of Defense (Comptroller). In this position, he is responsible for the review and analysis of all Defense programs financed with Procurement and Research, Development, Test and Evaluation (RDT&E) funds. Mr. Roth is a frequent speaker at the Defense Systems Management College and other forums on the subject of PPBS and the role of the OSD/OMB budget review process. Mr. Roth entered the Senior Executive Service in 1990. He is a member of the American Society of Military Comptrollers.

Mr. Roth graduated from the University of Virginia in 1974 with a Bachelor of Arts degree and earned a Master of Science degree in Public Administration from George Washington University in 1977. Mr. Roth has also completed the Executive Excellence Program at the Federal Executive Institute and the Program for Senior Managers in Government at Harvard University.
