

Fundamentals of Systems Acquisition Management (FSAM) ACQ-101

- Concepts/knowledge-based
- Introduction to policy, business, and technical areas of systems acquisition
- Target: Civilian GS-5/9, Military Senior NCOs, O1/O3
- 25 hours of Internet lessons
- Required for Level I Certification in most career fields
- Prerequisite: None

Intermediate Systems Acquisition Course (ISAC) ACQ-201

- Concepts/comprehension/application
- Scenario-based
– Integrated through Joint Services Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) Acquisition
- Target: Civilian GS-12/13; Military O3/O4
- 35 hours of Internet lessons and 1 week classroom (“hybrid” course)
- Required for Level II Certification in most career fields
- Prerequisite: ACQ-101

Program Management Tools Course (PMTc) PMT-250

- Concepts/application
- 7 tools (scenario-based) Integrated Product Team (IPT), Work Breakdown Structure (WBS), Scheduling, Cost Estimating, Risk Management, Contracting, Earned Value
 - Integrated through Joint Service Unmanned Aerial Vehicle Acquisition
- Target: Civilian GS-12/13; Military O3/O4
- 80 hours of Internet lessons
 - 56 hours individual work
 - 24 hours group work in virtual classroom
- Required for Level II Certification in PM career field
- Prerequisite: ACQ-201

Program Management Office Course (PMOC) PMT-352

- Analysis, synthesis, evaluation
- Scenario-based
 - Integrated through Joint Services System-of-Systems: Joint Reconnaissance Autonomous Targeting System (JRATS)
 - Stresses C3I/Interoperability
- Target: Civilian GS-13/14; Military O4/O5
- 50 hours of Internet lessons over 60 days, and 6 weeks in classroom (“hybrid” course)
- Required for Level III Certification in PM career field
- Prerequisite: ACQ-201 and PMT-250

Program Manager’s Course (PMC) PMT-401

- Analysis, synthesis, evaluation
- Case-based
 - Real-world PM dilemmas
 - Protagonist (actual PM) participation
 - Critical thinking emphasis
- Target: Civilian GS-14/15; Military O5/O6
- 10 weeks in classroom
- Required for potential ACAT I/IA/II PMs/Deputy PMs
- Prerequisite: PMT-352

Executive Program Manager’s Course (EPMC) PMT-402

- Curriculum tailored for each student
- Analysis, synthesis, evaluation
- Crosses myriad program management dilemmas/issues
- Target: Civilian GS-15/SES; Military O6/O7
- 4 weeks in classroom plus field assessments
- Required for ACAT I/II PMs/Deputy PMs
- Prerequisite: PMT-401
