On June 18, 2010, Scott J. Davis accepted responsibilities as Program Executive Officer Ground Combat Systems, the Army's premier acquisition organization providing the joint warfighter with mission-capable ground combat systems. Officiating at the change of leadership ceremony, from outgoing PEO GCS Brig. Gen. R. David Ogg to Davis, was Malcolm Ross O'Neill, Assistant Secretary of the Army for Acquisition, Logistics and Technology and Army Acquisition Executive.

The PEO is accountable for about \$35 billion per year, said O'Neill. He is "responsible for stewarding the resources of your tax money—the resources of the manpower, the material of the U.S. Army. It is a responsibility that is only able to be executed with the support of some very outstanding personnel."

Selected for the Senior Executive Service program in November 2005, Davis previously served as the Deputy PEO, Integration, and was responsible for the organization and management of acquisition programs to support brigade combat team modernization. Davis led development, production, fielding, and sustainment activities for systems such as the ground combat vehicle, unmanned ground vehicles, unmanned air systems, and unattended munitions.

An Army Reserve officer, Davis has held a variety of positions from platoon leader through battalion executive officer.

Ellis Named Troop Support Deputy Commander

In a message to senior DLA leaders, Thompson said Ellis “has quickly become a valued member of the DLA senior leadership team” in his current role.

“I am confident Rich will perform superbly in this challenging position,” he said.

Before coming to DSCP, Ellis served as contracts manager, readiness and sustainment, electronics, intelligence, and support for BAE Systems. He was responsible for providing contracting functional expertise, specifically as it related to Performance Based Logistics.

He retired from the Navy Supply Corps as a captain after a 26-year career in operational logistics, inventory management, and contracting. His last assignment in the Navy was director of contracting at Naval Inventory Control Point Philadelphia, where he was responsible for the acquisition of aviation and maritime repair parts, awarding more than 40,000 contracts valued in excess of \$4.5 billion annually. During his tenure, NAVICP awarded 30 performance-based logistics contracts. In addition, Ellis pioneered the use of on-line reverse auctions in the federal government.

Ellis holds a Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from Jacksonville University, a master’s in business administration from the University of Washington, and attended the Wharton School Executive Development Program at the University of Pennsylvania.

Ellis will replace Gilbert Montoya, who joined DSCP in 2007. Montoya is moving on to become the director of the 448th Supply Chain Management Wing at the Air Force Global Logistics Support Center, Air Force Materiel Command, at Tinker Air Force Base, Okla.
