Apply DAU Course Work to Degrees and Certificates

DAU has established strategic partnerships with universities and colleges so that DoD AT&L workforce members can transfer DAU course work toward college and university degrees and certificates. While each partnership is unique in what it offers, the objective of the partnership program is to provide you with opportunities to maximize your academic accomplishments by receiving credit for DAU courses toward an undergraduate, graduate, or certificate program offered by a strategic partner.

To help you find a program that suits your needs, DAU has developed an interactive Web-based Strategic Partnership Database. Here you can search for partnerships offering degree or certificate credits for DAU classes. The database allows you to narrow your search by career field, geographic area, or type of program desired.

Accelerate your Master's Degree

Accelerate is an exciting new program where you can earn your master degree in less time. Through this program, several universities are offering the AT&L workforce credit toward master degrees for Level II and Level III Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act (DAWIA) certification.



Webster University will apply 9 credits for DAWIA Level II Certification in Contracting toward their Master of Business Administration, Master of Arts in Procurement and Acquisitions, and Master of Arts in Management and Leadership.



Bellevue University will accept 9 hours of graduate level transfer credits for DAWIA Level II Certification in Contracting as a concentration in Acquisition and Contract Management for the Master of Business Administration degree or into the Master of Acquisition Management degree.



University of Maryland University College will award 9 credits for DAWIA Level III Project Management Certification for either the Master of Science in Management with a concentration in Project Management or the Master of Science in Technology Management with a concentration in Project Management.
