SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

The ABMC consists of a five-day resident (in-class) portion preceded by an internet-based (online) “pre-course” portion. The resident portion of BCF 211 consists of a series of instructor-facilitated group exercises where you will apply the concepts learned in pre-requisite courses (BCF 102 and BCF 103) and reviewed in the online pre-course portion of BCF 211. There will be very little instructor lecture in the in-residence portion, and you will be expected to have a basic knowledge of the pre-course material.

The BCF 211 pre-course consists of online lesson modules with three associated exams. The pre-course constitutes one of five graded deliverables which you are required to satisfactorily pass to graduate from BCF 211. (The other four graded deliverables will be discussed on the first day of the resident portion of the course.) To receive a satisfactory grade on the pre-course you must achieve 100% correct within three attempts on EACH of the three exams. The estimated time to complete the pre-course is approximately 21 hours (but varies based on student experience level).

Example: If Exam 1 contains 18 questions and you get 14 questions correct on attempt 1, your attempt 2 will contain four new questions on the topics missed in attempt 1. If you get three of four correct on attempt 2, your attempt 3 will contain one new question on the topic missed in attempt 2.

You will have 65 days to complete the online, pre-course portion of BCF 211. That 65-day period begins 76 days before the first day of the resident portion of the course. The deadline to complete the pre-course (the end of the 65-day period) is the Thursday that is 11 days prior to the Monday resident start date. Late registrants or waitlisted students receiving a reservation after the pre-course starts will have less than 65 days to complete the pre-course portion.
