Apply DAU Coursework to Degrees and Certificates

DAU has established strategic partnerships with universities and colleges so Defense Acquisition Workforce members can transfer DAU coursework toward college and university degrees and certificates. While each partnership is unique in what it offers, the objective of the partnership program is to provide you with opportunities to maximize your academic accomplishments by receiving credit for DAU courses toward an undergraduate, graduate, or certificate program offered by a strategic partner.

To help you find a program that suits your needs, DAU has developed an interactive Web-based Strategic Partnership Database. In the database, you can search for partnerships offering degree or certificate credits for DAU classes. The database allows you to narrow your search by career field, geographic area, or type of program desired.

Exceleerate Your Degree or Certificate



Exceleerate is an exciting program in which you can earn your master's degree or master-level certificate in less time. Through this program, several universities are offering the Defense Acquisition Workforce credit toward master's degrees and certificates of achievement for Level II and Level III Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act (DAWIA) certification.



Columbia Southern University will award nine semester hours of elective credit for DAWIA Level II Certification in Program Management toward a Master of Business Administration degree and also award nine semester hours of credit for DAU course PMT 401 toward a Master of Business Administration degree, Project Management concentration.



Webster University will award nine credits for DAWIA Level II certification in Contracting toward a Master of Business Administration, a Master of Arts in Procurement and Acquisitions, Management and a Master of Arts in Management and Leadership.



Bellevue University will accept nine hours of graduate-level transfer credits for DAWIA Level II certification in Contracting as a concentration in Acquisition and Contract Management for the Master of Business Administration degree or for the Master of Acquisition Management degree.



University of Maryland University College will award nine credits for DAWIA Level III Project Management certification for either the Master of Science in Management with a concentration in Project Management or the Master of Science in Technology Management with a concentration in Project Management.



Villanova University will award credit for DAWIA Level II or Level III certification for Essentials of Project Management towards the Master Certificate in Applied Project Management, subject to a Villanova University review of the individual's credentials.



University of Management and Technology will allow DAU courses toward Level II and Level III certification to transfer toward master's degrees and master-level certificates.
