

On-site Visits (DoD Organizations, Warfighter & Industry)

Throughout the 10 month program, Fellows tour selected DoD Organizations, Warfighter and Industry locations to hear from technical experts and the senior leaders at each location. These visits provide the Fellows with first-hand, eyes-on exposure to the latest technological advances in research, testing, manufacturing, training, and end user applications. **On-site visits** also provide the Fellows with opportunities to further develop their abilities to adapt to circumstances, think effectively under pressure, and focus solutions communicated effectively to others.

Planned on-site visits include but are not limited to:

- National Training Center, Fort Irwin, California and Joint Readiness Training Center, Fort Polk, Louisiana;
- Edgewood Chemical Biological Center and U.S. Army Test and Evaluation Command; Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland;
- BAE Systems, York, Pennsylvania;
- Defense Supply Center, Philadelphia and Defense Distribution Center at New Cumberland, Pennsylvania;
- U.S. Central Command and U.S. Special Operations Command, MacDill AFB, Tampa Florida and Team Orlando, Florida;
- International Trip – Europe: Sites of Strategic National Interest and WWI and WWII Staff Ride; and
- Antietam and Gettysburg Battlefield Staff Rides.
